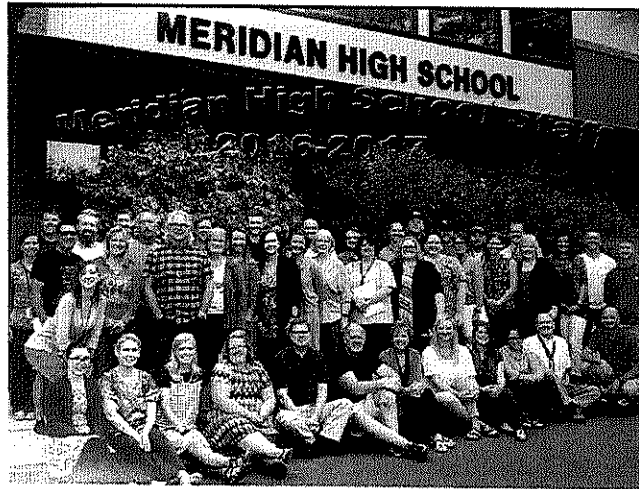


## Why T3?

We know that not everyone can always take advantage of that time offered by teachers or are able to use the tutorial center after school - whether you (students) have to take care of a sibling at home, work, participate in athletics, volunteer or have other commitments.

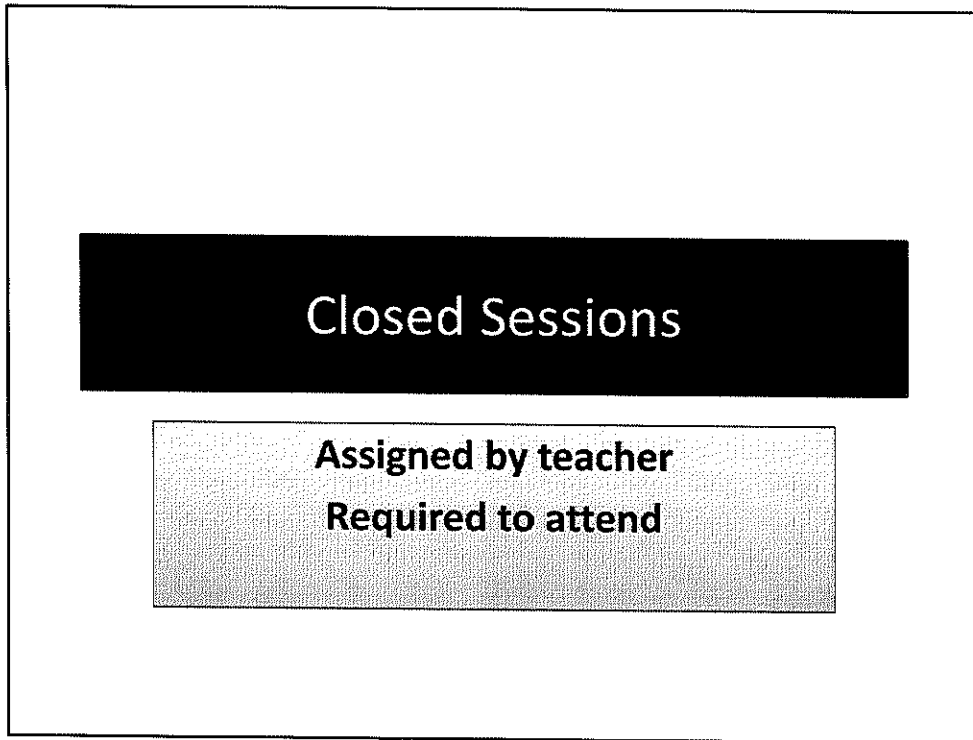
T3 allows for us to provide you (students) additional time and support to help you (students) be successful.

T3 gives dedicated time to help you (students) catch up on a missing assignment, complete you (students)r homework, make up a missed lab or test, or get help from a teacher to gain a better understanding a concept or developing a skill that you (students) have yet to master.



How does T3 work?

There three options on tutorial days - Commons/Library / Open Sessions / Closed Sessions



Most weeks there will be three 40 minute periods that provides you (students) this opportunity.

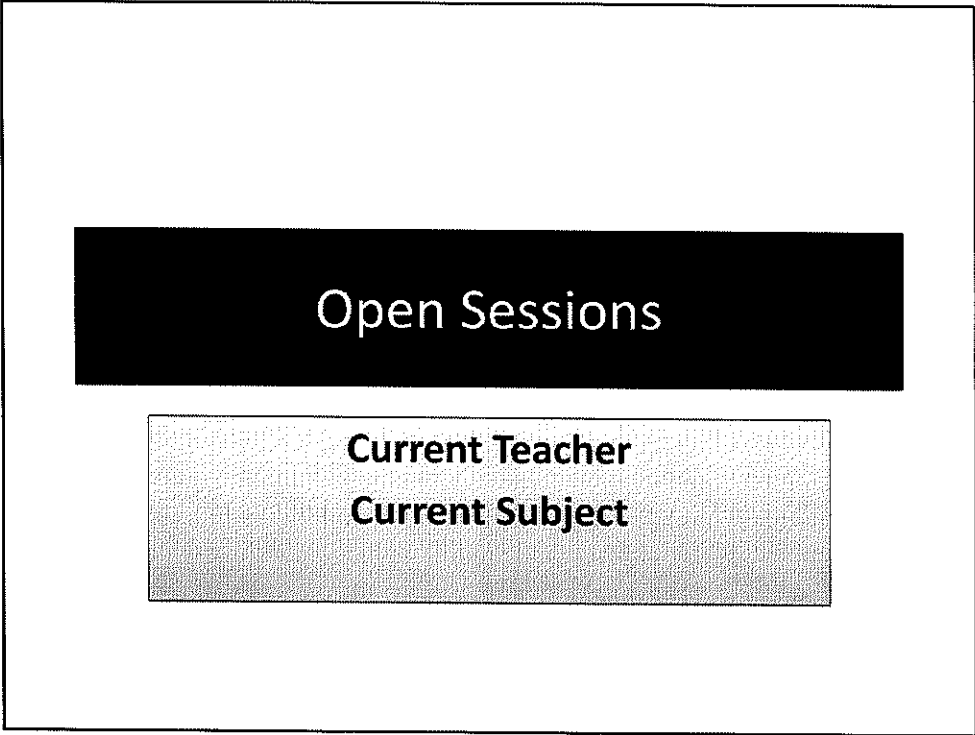
The week prior teachers will decide which students that they want to see the following week during T3.

On either Friday or Monday, the teacher who assigned you (students) will tell you (students) if they have assigned you (students) to a T3 closed session. you (students) need to write it down in you (students)r Planner.

All teachers will also have a list of students and can remind you (students) to attend a closed tutorial session.

On the assigned day, you (students) need to go to that classroom. If you do not attend, it will be marked absent and you will be considered truant.

Teachers will also decide which what topics/support each will be giving. This will include open sessions and closed sessions.



**Open sessions** will be available for students to attend who either have that teacher or that same subject with a different teacher.

Students will get a list of open sessions on Monday. If not assigned to a closed session, students will need to make a note of what sessions they are interested in attending for the week. On that day, students will need to go to that session when the bell rings at 10:35.

Some sessions will be popular so it is important to get to a room quickly or you (students) may not get you (students)r first choice.

## Library / Commons

**3.3 or above GPA**  
**Checked Every Four Weeks**

This is available for those students who currently a 3.3+ GPA based on a grade check. This section will be available for students until the next grade check, which happens about every four weeks.

For our first session, only 10-12 grade students are eligible. The GPA was taken from last spring. you (students) should have received you (students)r yellow card during first period today informing you (students) that you (students) have this option.



## Library Commons

**Library – silent work**  
**Commons – small group work**

Students with the **yellow card** can choose to go to the library (for quiet/silent study time) or the Commons for group study time during tutorial. Students will be expected to be focused on their studies and not other distractions. If you (students) can't do that then you (students) will lose this option for the remainder of the four week session.

This allows the student above to access the commons and library during Tutorial Days. The student must stay in one location for the entire time T3 is in session that day.

If the student above doesn't meet the behavior expectations s/he may lose the privilege of using the commons/library during the dates below.

If the student above is assigned to a closed tutorial session, s/he is obligated to attend that session. Failure to attend will be considered truancy. S/he may lose the privilege of using the commons/library along with other consequences.

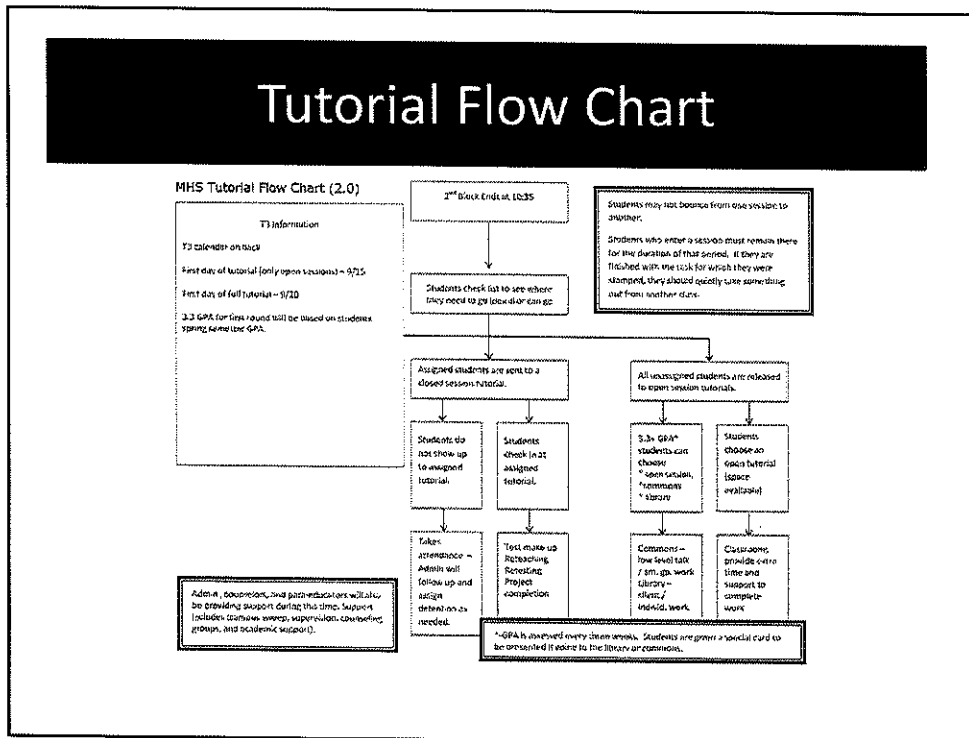
If the student loses this card, s/he will not be given another one and will be expected to attend open sessions in classrooms during the dates below.

While those with a yellow card can go to the commons and library, they can also choice to go to an open session to get help from a teacher OR may also be assigned to a closed session, which you (students) will be required to go to.
