



Enhanced Remote Learning - Student/Family Information

Students will focus on three classes for roughly 4.5 weeks. Students will attend those classes virtually four days a week, but will be expected to be working on their classes throughout the entire week. Students will also attend Homeroom^ five days a week.

The limited number of classes will allow students to focus on fewer subject areas (and teachers) making it easier to organize their time to learn the material presented to them in real-time and on-demand.

Classes for the first 4.5 week session will be 1st, 3rd, and 5th periods. Classes for the second 4.5 weeks will be 2nd, 4th, and 6th periods. (Schedules are still being finalized and not available on Skyward at this time).

All students will be provided a device beginning this week and teachers will be using google classroom to support student learning.

^ What is Homeroom? Students will attend homeroom each day to check-in with a staff member, receive needed information, tech support and build community with other students. Homeroom will also allow time and support for some graduation requirements to be completed (e.g. High School and Beyond Plan).

^^ What is T3? T3 will be available four days a week and will give specific time and support for students who may be struggling to learn/understand a specific topic or to stay caught up on their work. MHS will provide a post each week communicating the topic each teacher is focusing on during a T3 session. Based on their progress, and topics available, students will choose one of three things:

- 1 - A student will go to a teacher's T3 session to get help on work previously assigned in class.
- 2 - A student will be assigned by a teacher to attend T3 to help the student better understand specific content.
- 3 - A student feels they don't need help at this time and use the 30 minutes to work on previously assigned work.

^^^ What are Office Hours? Teachers will have office hours each day of the week to answer student questions to come visit during that time. Staff may also use the time to answer questions they may have been posed by email, in google classroom or through a phone call.
