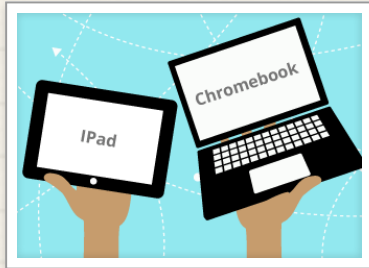

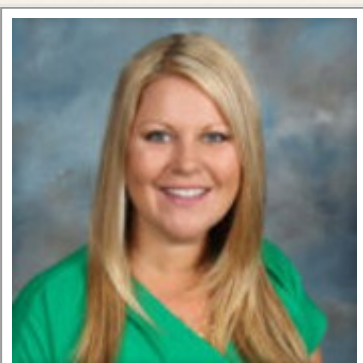
## Student Learning Plans (SLP)
