Introduction: Director of Food and Nutrition Rob Dunn welcomed those in attendance. The group reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting and approved them.

General discussion:

- A group member suggested that high school students be invited again to participate on the advisory group.
- Rob suggested an increase in supervision in the MMS cafeteria during lunch.
- In procedure 6700 under Children with Special Dietary Needs, a group member referenced the anaphylaxis form for children with dietary needs. This form is on district website on the Health Services webpage. Make sure that families are aware of this.
- In procedure 6700, Rob reviewed Best Practices for Meal Service.
 - Rob suggested that meal prices need to be posted in more places.
- In procedure 6700 in the section about Water, a group member expressed concerns about students bringing juice to school in water bottles. Look into water policy.
- In procedure 6700 in the Celebrations and Rewards section, the members felt the district approved list is not age-appropriate and lacks options to motivate students. Wondered about how these fit into the wellness policy.
- In procedure 6700 in the Nutrition Promotion section, it was suggested that DECA courses be removed from the procedure.
