Agenda

- **Welcome and Introductions** - Director of Special Services Aaron Jacoby welcomed the advisory group and set the tone for the meeting. Mr. Jacoby asked the advisory group members to introduce themselves and share their familiarity with AI. The group had varied experiences, with some using AI daily in their work, and others just learning about it.
- **Advisory Group Purpose** - Mr. Jacoby explained the work of the advisory group and the next steps for the meeting. The advisory group will first review Procedure 2022. The group will review examples from other school districts and a model policy from WSSDA.
- **Policy review (2022 Procedure - Electronic Resources and Internet Safety)**
 - Meridian School District - The group reviewed the current district policy and noticed:
 - The current policy lacks any mention to AI.
 - The current policy lacks a robust explanation of digital citizenship.
 - The current policy says there will be an anonymous way to request websites to be unblocked, this is not the current process.
 - The personal device use section, does this make sense to reference or include one-to-one devices?
 - The personal device section seems to contradict other policies.
 - Expand the Internet Safety and Instruction, this section could be expanded to address or include AI.
 - Peninsula School District
 - The group reviewed this policy and found it to be the same as Meridian's current policy.
 - Quincy School District
 - Very similar to model language.
 - Expanded Internet Safety Instruction piece and a whole section related to AI.



- A section about care for devices.
- WSSDA model policy
 - Internet Safety and Instruction areas are expanded.
 - Liked that there was a full section about internet safety.
 - Appropriate use of AI is included in 2022.
 - Has strong language in the disciplinary section.
- Meeting closure
 - Mr. Jacoby thanked everyone for their work today. He outlined resources he'd like the group to review before our next meeting.
- Next steps
 - Review input and create draft policy
